Caring for Your Hand-Painted Aluminum Art

Simple Steps to Protect Your Art

1. Wash and Wax Twice a Year

Gently clean and wax your piece at least every 6 months.

Live near the ocean? Do it more often to guard against salt and moisture.

2. Use Car Soap — Not Dish Soap

Car soap protects the wax layer.

Avoid kitchen soaps — they strip away protective coatings.

3. Remove Mildew if Needed

Use a **50/50 diluted chlorine solution** to spot-clean mildew.

Rinse thoroughly before waxing.

4. Try Wet-Apply Spray Waxes

Many waxes can be sprayed on while your piece is still wet after washing —

No drying or buffing required and no chalky residue.
